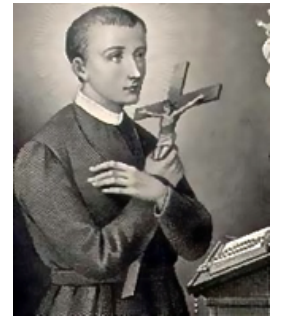

## Third Sunday of Advent - Mass Readings (Year A) - December 13 & 14, 2025

**Entrance Antiphon:** Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near.

### First Reading - Isaiah 35: 1-6,10

Let the wilderness and the dry-lands exult, let the wasteland rejoice and bloom, let it bring forth flowers like the jonquil, let it rejoice and sing for joy. The glory of Lebanon is bestowed on it, the splendour of Carmel and Sharon; they shall see the glory of the Lord, the splendour of our God. Strengthen all weary hands, steady all trembling knees and say to all faint hearts, 'Courage! Do not be afraid. 'Look, your God is coming, vengeance is coming, the retribution of God; he is coming to save you.' Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, the ears of the deaf unsealed, then the lame shall leap like a deer and the tongues of the dumb sing for joy for those the Lord has ransomed shall return. They will come to Zion shouting for joy, everlasting joy on their faces; joy and gladness will go with them and sorrow and lament be ended.

**Responsorial Psalm:** Lord, come and save us.

### Second Reading - James 5:7-10

Be patient, brothers, until the Lord's coming. Think of a farmer: how patiently he waits for the precious fruit of the ground until it has had the autumn rains and the spring rains! You too have to be patient; do not lose heart, because the Lord's coming will be soon. Do not make complaints against one another, brothers, so as not to be brought to judgement yourselves; the Judge is already to be seen waiting at the gates. For your example, brothers, in submitting with patience, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.

**Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia!** The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me; He sent Me to bring the Good News to the poor. *Alleluia!*

### Gospel Reading - Matthew 11:2-11

John in his prison had heard what Christ was doing and he sent his disciples to ask him, 'Are you the one who is to come, or have we got to wait for someone else?' Jesus answered, 'Go back and tell John what you hear and see; the blind see again, and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised to life and the Good News is proclaimed to the poor; and happy is the man who does not lose faith in me.' As the messengers were leaving, Jesus began to talk to the people about John: 'What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed swaying in the breeze? No? Then what did you go out to see? A man wearing fine clothes? Oh no, those who wear fine clothes are to be found in palaces. Then what did you go out for? To see a prophet? Yes, I tell you, and much more than a prophet: he is the one of whom scripture says: 'Look, I am going to send my messenger before you; he will prepare your way before you. 'I tell you solemnly, of all the children born of women, a greater than John the Baptist has never been seen; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he is.'

**Communion Antiphon:** Say to the faint of heart: Be strong and do not fear. Behold, our God will come, and He will save us.

## Daily Antiphons - Monday December 15 to Saturday December 20, 2025

### Monday of the Third Week of Advent - December 15

**Entrance Antiphon:** Hear the word of the Lord, O nations; declare it to the distant lands: Behold, our Saviour will come; you need no longer fear.

**Responsorial Psalm:** Teach me Your ways, O Lord.

**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia!* Lord, show us Your mercy and love, and grant us Your salvation. *Alleluia!*

**Communion Antiphon:** Come, O Lord, visit us in peace, that we may rejoice before You with a blameless heart.

### Tuesday of the Third Week of Advent - December 16

**Entrance Antiphon:** Behold, the Lord will come, and all His holy ones with Him; and on that day there will be a great light.

**Responsorial Psalm:** The Lord hears the cry of the poor.

**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia!* Come, O Lord, do not delay: Forgive the sins of Your people. *Alleluia!*

**Communion Antiphon:** The Just Judge will bestow a crown of righteousness on those who eagerly await His coming.

### Wednesday of the Third Week of Advent - December 17

**Entrance Antiphon:** Rejoice, O Heavens, and exult, O earth, for our Lord will come to show mercy to His poor.

**Responsorial Psalm:** Justice shall flourish in His time, and fullness of peace for ever.

**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia!* Come, Wisdom of our God Most High, guiding creation with power and love: teach us to walk in the paths of knowledge! *Alleluia!*

**Communion Antiphon:** Behold, the Desired of all the nations will come, and the house of the Lord will be filled with glory.

### Thursday of the Third Week of Advent - December 18

**Entrance Antiphon:** Christ our King is coming, He is the Lamb foretold by John.

**Responsorial Psalm:** Justice shall flourish in His time and fullness of peace for ever.

**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia!* Come, Leader of ancient Israel, giver of the Law of Moses on Sinai: rescue us with Your mighty power! *Alleluia!*

**Communion Antiphon:** His name will be called Emmanuel, which means God-with-us.

### Friday of the Third Week of Advent - December 19

**Entrance Antiphon:** He who is to come will come and will not delay, and now there will be no fear within our land for He is our Saviour.

**Responsorial Psalm:** Fill me with Your praise, and I will sing Your glory!

**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia!* Come, Flower of Jesse's stem, sign of God's love for all His people: save us without delay! *Alleluia!*

**Communion Antiphon:** The Dawn from on high will visit us, guiding our feet in the way of peace.

### Saturday of the Third Week of Advent - December 20

**Entrance Antiphon:** A branch shall sprout from the root of Jesse, and the glory of the Lord will fill the whole earth, and all flesh will see the salvation of God.

**Responsorial Psalm:** Let the Lord enter; He is king of glory.

**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia!* Come, Key of David, opening the gates of God's eternal kingdom: free the prisoners of darkness! *Alleluia!*

**Communion Antiphon:** The Angel said to Mary: Behold, you will conceive and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus.
